On March 23rd Beamsville 4PawRescue was shocked and need your help in finding out who could be so cruel to an animal. A cardboard box, taped up with packing tape so no air could circulate, was left on a doorstep for hours until someone opened it and saw two little green eyes staring back. The person who found the box called us and when Pam from Beamsville 4PawRescue opened the box, it was filled with blood and a 7-month old pregnant kitten.



We rushed the kitten to the vets as the babies had all shifted to the side and the mother couldn't breathe or stand. There was a 4-inch cut on her side that was about ½ inch deep. The mother, who we now call Dolly, was in critical condition. If anyone can give information about who left the box or who owned Dolly we would like to hear from you. Dolly was found in Welland at the corner of Wilton and Lincoln Street West. On April 2nd 2012 -Dolly gave birth to 8 healthy beautiful babies. Dolly is a great mom and even though she is a 7-month-old kitten herself, she is devoting her kitten life to taking of her babies.

We have adopted 5 babies and are currently looking for a "Forever Home" for Dolly and her 2 female kittens, Hadley and Lilly.
