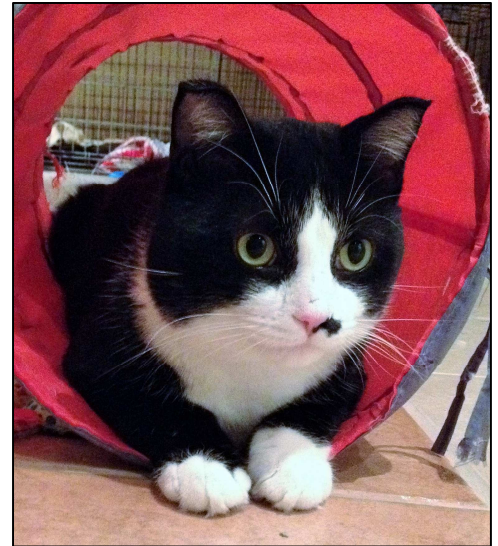

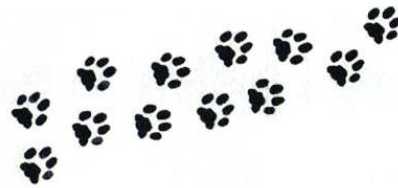

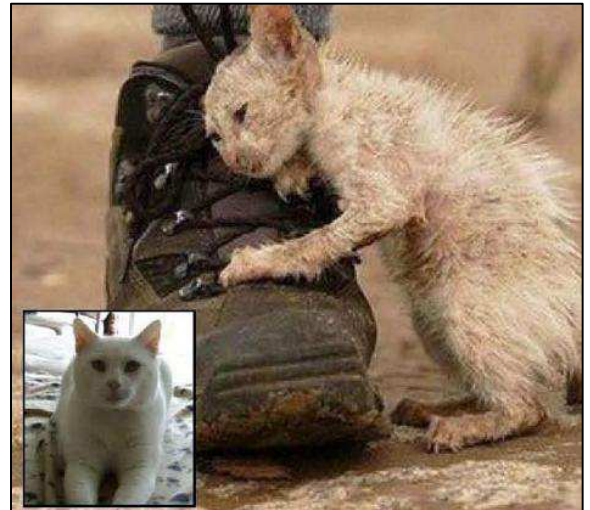
Local Feel Good Stories!

Scrappy 1; 1997

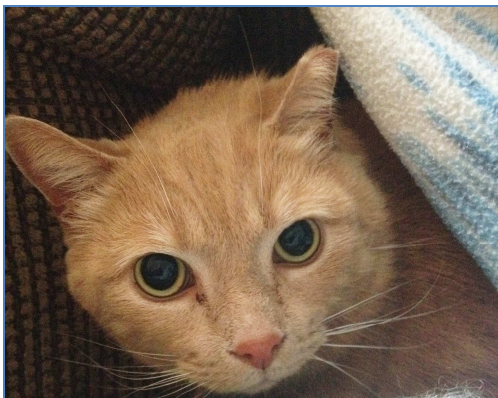
Meet Scrappy! This is where it all began. Many times we are asked how Beamsville 4Paw started and we refer to this story and photo.



Two people going for a walk and hear small cat cries for help coming from under a wood pile. Do you walk away and assume it is someone's Cat or do you make the choice to "Save a Life"? We were not a rescue then just people who love animals. When we started following the cries and were shocked to find a helpless cat with broken legs and open wounds lying in a middle of a mud patch. We had heavy rain the past few days and construction was all around us. The cat looked like it was trying to find shelter in a woodpile and it fell on top of her. We started moving the wood pile and wrapped the cat in my coat so we can bring the cat to help. When we looked down a small starving, cold and almost lifeless kitten gripping a boot was there.
